Message from Co-Founders

"Ability is evenly distributed, opportunities are not"

The 2022/2023 academic year has been a testament to our progress and impact, as we continue to empower students nationwide. Here is a glimpse of our journey this year:

Student Impact: Over the past year, we have proudly supported 400 students across Ireland. These students have become role models within their schools (the average grade improvement of our students in their chosen subject was 22% and 92% of all jumpAgrade students progressed onto further education). As we look back, we know that our mission to create positive change is only just beginning.

Teacher Mentors: Behind the scenes, the jumpAgrade operational team and our inspirational teacher mentors are working tirelessly to develop our programme and deepen our impact. All 400 students worked with their own personal teacher mentor. Our programme aligns with our core purpose: helping underrepresented students progress to further education, apprenticeships and skilled work.

Closing the Opportunity Gap: While student ability is distributed evenly, opportunity is not. In Ireland, a growing "grinds" culture has emerged, with students seeking extra tuition to boost their grades. This culture often favours those with financial means, exacerbating educational disparities. Feepaying schools have significantly higher progression rates compared to DEIS schools and other underrepresented students.

Our Commitment: At jumpAgrade, we are committed to levelling the playing field of Irish education. Our aim is to be recognised as the National Tuition Service for underrepresented students by 2025. Our work focuses on ensuring that all students have equal access to the opportunities they deserve.

Our journey continues, and the impact we strive for is yet to be fully realised. Together, we will break down barriers and empower students.


